From Competition Committee Member Peter Grubenmann, Switzerland

- A great and perfectly organized Championship by our friends from Finland is over. The competition ran smoothly, efficiently and all the systems used worked perfect, highly effective and very important - perfectly at time schedule. All persons involved at practicing pool area, bibbing area, sand and seeding area, competition area, speakers, scrutineers and all supervisors at the competition area worked very efficient and to everybody's happiness!
- The spirit and philosophy of the World Goldpanning Association of fair play and sportsmanship prevailed throughout the event.
- As far as I know, we had 140 Women and 194 Men participating at the two main categories. Out of them, there was 137 Veterans and in addition approximately 30 Juniors.
- After I was appointed by Esko Orava, our Chairman, to write the Competition report on behalf of the WGA Spring-Meeting Members. I asked various Competitors from nearly all the participating countries to please tell me all about any hints or meanings concerning the running Competition, any Competition improvement suggestions as well as any complaints they may have of what's however concerning the Competition. full of good words and thankful to everybody who contributed to and for the perfectly organized Competition.

9. Youth /Children / family programs

The Board has discussed at SBM on the 18th of June of Family events in competitions and how they should be controlled in future. This item still needs some fine-tuning however, it was agreed that the role of the LOC of each event will provide guidance.

When the Board last year made a decision to support Tankavaara Children's' program during the WGC 2019, a feedback how this was arranged and succeeded was required.

Following report from Tankavaara Gold Village by Marko Touru was accepted:

Report: Children's programs at 2019 World Gold Panning Championships in Tankavaara, Finland

Planning

Children's program was planned by Competition project secretary together with local municipality's culture secretary. Plan was to utilize local resources such as sports clubs etc. Local associations that participated: Lapin Kiehiset, Sodankylän Kisasiskot, 4h-kerho, Lappi Leader project.

Program

Organized and guided children's programs were organized from Tuesday to Friday 10:00-15:00 during the World Gold Panning Championships. Themed workshops schedule and the associations responsible for arranging:

Tuesday 6.8. Gold Village nature workshop – Local Scouts association

Wed 7.8. Rhythm & movement music and sports worskshop - Kisasiskot

Thu 8.8. Tankavaara Gold adventure – 4H

Fri 9.8. Nature day in Lapland - Tankavaara Gold Village

The workshops were aimed at children aged 7 and up. Maximum group size for each workshop was 25 at a time. All workshops started from Nugget square and happened in Tankavaara area.

Lappi Leader project also held a face painting booth at the market for a few days during the competitions.

8-10 children attended the workshops daily, mainly competitors' children. Turnout was smaller than expected, propably due to chilly weather. Also, local children's summer holiday had just ended before the competitions started.

Feedback

Competitors who gave feedback were very happy about the guided children's activities, since competitions usually don't have activities only for children. Also the children who attended the activities said they liked the workshops.
